Curriculum Overview

From Grades 5 to 13 –
A Broad and Flexible Educational Pathway

Grades 5–6 (Lower Secondary)

- Core subjects: German, Math, English, Science, Humanities, Arts, Music, Sports, Computer Science
- Early support for independent learning and self-regulation

Grades 7–8

- Electives: French, Chinese, Natural Sciences, Economy & Work
- Differentiation in Math and English through internal streaming (advanced/basic)

Grades 9–10

- Subjects: Advanced and basic courses in core subjects
- Additional project-based courses in sciences, humanities, and MINT subjects

Grades 11–13 (Upper Secondary)

- Advanced level courses, with new language options (Spanish, French)
- University preparation and diverse elective options

- Homework-free learning times during the school day

- Regular school events: School festivals, carnival, Halloween party, summer celebration



Learning Journey - Key Features

Grades 5 - 13

- Smooth transition into secondary school with strong start programs, diagnostic assessments and learning support
- Focus on self-regulation, responsibility, and teamwork from early years
- Broad elective choices and project-based learning to explore individual strengths
- Career orientation through internships, workshops, and real-world experiences
- Enrichment programs like Youth Debates to foster critical thinking
- Educational trips to strengthen independence and cultural experience
- Personalized guidance and mentoring, including peer tutoring and talent support (Talent scouting collaboration with Ruhr University Bochum)
- Multiple graduation pathways, including qualification for upper secondary education
